Conference Objectives

The Interprofessional Preceptor

- 4. Describe how dysfunctional behaviors related to hierarchy and power affect interprofessional learning in practice and offer strategies to prevent and address this behavior.

- 3. Identify IPPE community activities and IPPE institutional activities appropriate for learners at the conclusion of the P1 and P2 years, respectively.
- 4. Describe how the P1-P3 curriculum, IPPE community, and IPPE institutional activities contribute to a P4 student's APPE readiness.
